Participants leave the camp with the full experience of video production, including teamwork and troubleshooting, have a short film for their demo reel, and friendships that may well develop into further film making collaborations. The camp is fast-paced and fun, and our past participants have been thrilled with the outcome!

Interview Process:

1. Each High School will select one candidate to be interviewed by the Rotary Club of Burnaby
2. Date of Interview: December 6, 2017 between 9am and 12 noon (details to follow)
3. Candidates from each high school will be interviewed by representatives of the Rotary Club of Burnaby
4. Interviews should last approximately 15 to 20 minutes
5. Candidates should have an understanding of Rotary and its priorities
